Old Business:

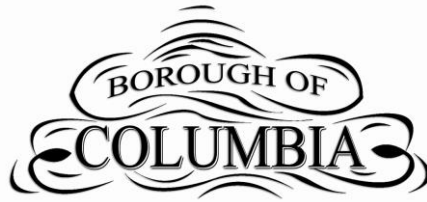
- a. Special Trash Hauling Permit- Committee discussed the current ordinance related to trash collections and recycling. It has been noted that information from the ordinances was inadvertently dropped from the codes during the recent codification process and therefore, there is a need to review all documents pertaining to this topic for correction.

Action: Welsh will email borough staff for all committee members to receive all information that is on file related to trash collection and recycling, going back to 2002.

New Business:

- a. Committee was presented with information regarding a proposed ordinance that included:
 - a. Amending the zoning ordinance for the tract of land at the Farm to allow the building of an animal shelter. Specifically, it would add a provision changing the use of a kennel in the Commercial Recreation District from allowed by special exception to permitted by right. This would address the issues that we discussed with respect to the Borough Farm for use by the Columbia Animal Shelter.
 - b. Implementing requested changes to the zoning ordinance from Union Station Restaurant as modified by the Legislative Committee to remove the side yard setbacks in the DC District and to expand the Downtown Commercial District to include the properties at 169 and 171 South Fourth Street.
